WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, by approving a Resolution on August 7, 1990, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", caused Holly Hill Road, a County-maintained Local Residential road, to be posted 40 M.P.H.,

WHEREAS, the Polk County Roads & Drainage Division has since conducted speed studies for Holly Hill Road (Road Number 770501); from County Road 547 (Davenport Boulevard) (Mile Post 0.00) to US Highway 27 (Mile Post 1.97). Located in S-5, T-27S, R-27E, and

WHEREAS, said studies were made in accordance with the procedures established by the State of Florida Department of Transportation, and said studies verified that a posting of 35 M.P.H. is reasonable, and

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Florida, the Board of County Commissioners is vested with the authority to establish speed limits on County maintained roads,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Polk County Roads & Drainage Division is herewith directed to cause Holly Hill Road to be posted 35 M.P.H., from County Road 547 (Davenport Boulevard) (Mile Post 0.00) to US Highway 27 (Mile Post 1.97). Further, the Resolution dated August 7, 1990, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby repealed.




