### **SUBJECT**

Approve the contract with Tri-County Human Services, Inc. to provide behavioral health services to eligible low-income county residents who are not Polk HealthCare Plan members. (total amount not to exceed \$700,000 annually)

### **DESCRIPTION**

Tri-County Human Services, Inc. (TCHS) provides behavioral health services in an office setting and/or via telehealth support. Services are provided to Polk County residents whose income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines and who are uninsured or not otherwise Polk HealthCare Plan members.

This contract will be effective October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2024. A fee schedule has been established to reimburse TCHS an agreed upon rate for services.

This funding request was presented to and approved by the Citizen's HealthCare Oversight Committee (COC) at the March 18, 2022 meeting.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Request Board approve the contract with Tri-County Human Services, Inc. to provide behavioral health services to eligible low-income county residents who are not Polk HealthCare Plan members.
