Alcohol Separation Requirements & Hours

Request:

Text amendment to Chapter 2, Section 224, Alcohol Sales, to amend separation distance measurements from property/lease line to shortest legal pedestrian route; to reduce distance separations from religious institutions and schools for 1COP, 2COP, 4COP, and 3PS licenses; and to allow liquor package sales on Sundays and adjust COP Sunday hours.

Section 224 Alcohol Sales (Revised 08/13/18; Ord. 18:49; 04/17/18; Ord. 18-023; 12/20/11; Ord. 11-042; 3/25/03 - Ord. 3-26; 7/25/01 - Ord. 01-57)

Distance Separation

Amend Table 4.3 to reduce distances from religious institutions and school separation for the following:

- Beer and wine consumption on the premises from 1,000 feet to 500 feet (1COP & 2COP).
- Beer, wine, and liquor consumption on the premises from 2,500 feet to 1,000 feet (4COP).
- Liquor package sales from 2,500 feet to 750 feet (3PS).

Method of Measurement

Change measurement option by **shortest route of pedestrian travel** instead of via property lines.

Hours of Operation

- Extending the hours in which beer, wine, and liquor consumption on premises can be sold on Sundays by one hour. From 11:00 A.M. to 12:00 A.M. Monday (1COP, 2COP, 4COP).
- **Permitting hours** for **liquor in closed containers** (package) on **Sundays** from 12:00 P.M. to 12:00 A.M. Monday (3PS).

Distance Separation Summary

- Since 2012, **all variances** to reduce separation requirements **have been approved** by the Land Use Hearing Officer or Board of Adjustment:
- POLK COUNTY Florida's Crossreads of Opportunity

- Average reduction in 1, 2, & 4 COP distance separation: 424 feet. (5 approved, 0 denied)
- Average reduction in 3PS distance separation: 568 feet. (11 approved, 0 denied)
- Beer and wine consumption on the premises from 1,000 feet to 500 feet (1COP & 2COP).
- Beer, wine, and liquor consumption on the premises from 2,500 feet to 1,000 feet (4COP).

• Liquor package sales from 2,500 feet to 750 feet (3PS).

Measurement Summary

POLK COUNTY

Forda's Cressroads of Opportunity

- Measure separation distance instead of property line or "how the crow flies" to ... "the shortest legal route of pedestrian travel along or across public roads, alleys, streets, sidewalks, or public thoroughfares from the centerline of the principal entrance of such establishment to the centerline of the principal entrance of the nearest religious institution or the nearest point of a school ground in use as part of the school facility,"...
- Only **two municipalities** measure distance via property lines.
- Only **one county** measures distance via property lines.
- More accurate depiction of real-world phenomena.



LDLVAR-2021-122

- 2COP licenses require 1,000' separation from a church/school
- Property lines: under 1,000 feet
- Door to door: over 1,000 feet



LDLVAR-2022-36

- 4COP licenses require 2,500' separation from a church/school
- Property line: 2,100 feet
- Building to building: over 2,500 feet
- Door to door: +/- 1.25 miles




Sunday Sales Summary

- POLK
- To allow liquor package sales on Sundays (3PS license) Sunday 12:00 PM until 12:00 AM Monday next.

Inconsistent regulations across the County

• Extend consumption on premises hours one hour earlier starting at 11AM (1,2,4COP license)



- Unincorporated portions of the County are losing package sales revenue on Sundays. 83.6% of the County is unincorporated.
- Based on 13 counties analyzed, Polk is the **only County** which **prohibits Sunday sales.**

Section 224 Alcohol Sales (Revised 08/13/18; Ord. 18:49; 04/17/18; Ord. 18-023; 12/20/11; Ord. 11-042; 3/25/03 - Ord. 3-26; 7/25/01 - Ord. 01-57)

All alcohol sales shall conform to the following:

- 1. No Certificate of Approval shall be issued, and no place of business shall be established, in the territory lying without the limits of incorporated municipalities in Polk County, Florida, for the sale of malt beverages having an alcoholic content of more than 1 percent by weight, or wine regardless of alcoholic content, for consumption on the premises, which place of business within 1,000 feet 500 feet of any established religious institution or public and private kindergarten thru 12th grade school located outside of a Commercial Future Land Use Map District.
- 2. No Certificate of Approval shall be issued, and no place of business shall be established, in the territory lying without the limits of incorporated municipalities in Polk County, Florida for the sale of alcoholic beverages having an alcoholic content of greater than 1 percent by weight (except malt beverages and wine) which place of business is within 2,500 feet (package sales) and 1,000 feet (consumption on the premises) of an established religious institution or public and private kindergarten thru 12th grade school located outside of a Commercial Future Land Use Map District.

- 5. The table to follow illustrates the required distance between the business property for which the type of license is applied and religious institutions or kindergarten thru 12th grade schools (public or private) located outside of a Commercial Future Land Use Map District. The distance separation shall be measured so that no point on the property/lease line of the business applying for the Certificate of Approval shall be located closer than the applicable minimum distance from any point on the property/lease line of the church or school by following the shortest legal route of pedestrian travel along or across public roads, alleys, streets, sidewalks, or public thoroughfares from the centerline of the principal entrance of such establishment to the centerline of the principal entrance of the nearest religious institution or the nearest point of a school ground in use as part of the school facility, located outside of a Commercial Future Land Use Map District.

Request:

- These changes to distance, measurement, and hours provides more consistency when compared to other jurisdictions.
- Purpose of distance separations will be better implemented and more effectively align with real-world phenomena.

- Changes to hours of operation helps the County maintain competitiveness for economic opportunities and development.
