

RESOLUTION NO. 26-

WHEREAS, pursuant to Polk County Ordinance 08-015, as amended, the Fire Chief or the Fire Chief's Designee has repealed Fire Department Burn Ban 25-02; and

WHEREAS, less than fifty percent (50%) of Polk County is averaging over 500 on the Keetch-Byram Drought Index; and

WHEREAS, since the declaration of said Fire Department Burn Ban the atmospheric and fire hazard conditions that increased the risk of brush fires and uncontrolled fires throughout Polk County have abated; and

WHEREAS, a repeal of a Fire Department Burn Ban must be approved by resolution at the next regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the Repeal of Fire Department Burn Ban 25-02 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved.

NOTICE OF REPEAL OF FIRE DEPARTMENT BURN BAN NO. 25-02

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2025, the Polk County Fire Chief declared Fire Department Burn Ban No. 25-02;

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2026, Fire Department Burn Ban No. 25-02, was suspended temporarily for seven (7) days until 11:59PM EST on April 16, 2026, pursuant to Polk County Fire Chief Order No. 26-01.

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2026, Fire Department Burn Ban No. 25-02, was suspended temporarily for an additional seven (7) days until 11:59PM EST on April 24, 2026, pursuant to Polk County Fire Chief Order No. 26-02.

WHEREAS, less than fifty percent (50%) of Polk County is averaging over 500 on the Keetch-Byram Drought Index:

WHEREAS, Polk County Ordinance 08-015, as amended, authorizes the Fire Chief or the Fire Chief's Designee to repeal a Fire Department Burn Ban upon abatement of the fire hazard conditions; and

WHEREAS, since the declaration of said Fire Department Burn Ban, the atmospheric and fire hazard conditions that increased the risk of brush fires and uncontrolled fires throughout Polk County have abated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED BY THE POLK COUNTY FIRE CHIEF THAT:


PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF POLK COUNTY ORDINANCE 08-015, AS AMENDED, THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BURN BAN 25-02 IS HEREBY DECLARED REPEALED EFFECTIVE APRIL 17, 2026.


