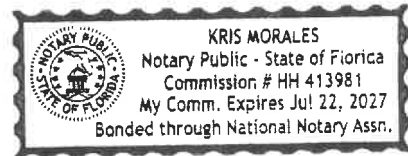

Tripp Owings

Chief Executive Officer West Florida Division



Tripp Owings currently serves as CEO of HCA Florida Brandon Hospital, a level F facility, in HCA's West Florida Division. The facility is located in Brandon, FL (a fast growing region in unincorporated Hillsborough County and bedroom community, east of Tampa). At present, HCA Florida Brandon Hospital comprises 436 beds, 5 FSEDs (Plant City, University, Riverview, Lakeland and New Tampa) and the Brandon Surgery Center (the highest volume ASC in HCA).

Tripp's career with HCA started in the Southeast Division in 2002 in Atlanta. Prior to his current role, Tripp served as CEO of Medical Center of Trinity, a 340 licensed bed facility comprised of five campuses; the primary acute campus, a behavioral health campus and three free standing emergency rooms. Tripp was COO of Wesley Medical Center/Wesley Children's Hospital, a 760 bed hospital where he led the design and construction of the Children's Hospital. Tripp later accepted the CEO position at Wesley Woodlawn Hospital & ER in 2016, a 99 licensed bed facility. During his tenure at Wichita, where Tripp successfully launched TAVR, ECMO, Watchman, and Mitral Clip programs resulting in a 10.7% increase in open-heart volume. Tripp gave back to the community by forming the Wesley Children's Foundation to support pediatric programs and services in Wichita along with chairing the Wichita Heart Ball for two years alongside his wife.

A Georgia native, Tripp earned his Bachelor's degree in Finance from the University of Georgia. Tripp earned his Master's degree in Business Administration from Mississippi State University. Tripp is also a fellow of the Fellow American College of Healthcare Executives (FACHE).

Gary Searls is the Chief Financial Officer at Brandon Regional Hospital since March 2017.
