WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Polk County, during the preparation of its 2022-23 budget, did not anticipate additional cash revenues into or expenditures from the 16000 Street Lighting Districts, and

WHEREAS, the said funds were received and approved for specific purpose to the total amount of \$60,500; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the authority granted in Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06(2)(d), this Board may amend its budget to include the receipt of such funds and to appropriate the expenditure of such additional costs;
