CONSULTANT SERVICE AGREEMENT #17-063 AMENDMENT# 2

This Amendment, effective as of the date executed by the County (the "Effective Date"), is hereby entered into by and between Polk County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, (the "County"), situated at 330 W. Church Street, Bartow, Florida 33830, and Carollo Engineers, Inc. (the "Consultant") a Delaware corporation, headquartered at 2700 Ygnacio Valley Road, Suite 300, Walnut Creek, CA 94598 whose Federal Employer Identification Number is 86-0899222.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and the Consultant entered into that certain Consultant Service Agreement #17-063 dated August 4, 2017 (the "Agreement") for professional engineering services related to the preliminary and final design services, permitting, bidding and construction administration phase services of the Northwest Regional Utility Service Area (NWRUSA) Gibson Oaks Water Production Facility, and the services are to be performed in phases (each a "Part"); and

WHEREAS, Exhibit "D" of the Agreement set forth the preliminary engineering services which comprised Part 1 of the Project Scope of Services, and were limited to project management support services, preliminary design, permitting, and optional raw water supply well bid and construction administration phase services; and

WHEREAS, the estimated time for the Consultant to complete Part 1 services of the Project was 350 calendar days for a total not-to-exceed cost of \$461,235.38, as further set forth in Exhibit "D" of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Consultant modified the Agreement with Amendment #1 to Agreement 17-063 dated June 7, 2018, for Part 2 services related to project management, support, final design, permitting, bidding, and construction administration services as further described in Exhibit "A" of Amendment #1; and

WHEREAS, the estimated time for the Consultant to complete Part 2 services was 1,041 calendar days for a total not-to-exceed cost of \$1,564,120.47 as further set forth in Exhibit "A" of Amendment #1; and

WHEREAS, by this Amendment #2, the parties desire to modify the Agreement to identify and describe the professional engineering services required for Part 3 of the Project, including, without limitation, additional construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16.0 of the Agreement, the County and the Consultant mutually agree to amend the Agreement as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and the Consultant hereby agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is hereby modified and amended to identify and describe the professional engineering services required by the County and to be provided by the Consultant for Part 3 of the Project which includes, without limitation, additional construction phase services, which is more fully set forth and described in **Exhibit "A"** hereto titled "Gibson Oaks Water Production Facility Improvements (Part 3)" (the "Part 3 Services").

2. It is anticipated that the Part 3 Services shall be completed within approximately 90 calendar

days from the Effective Date of this Amendment #2, but in any event, shall be provided by the Consultant through final completion of the construction.

3. In consideration for its providing the Part 3 Services, the County shall pay the Consultant a not-to-exceed cost of \$136,477.00 to be billed in accordance with the Hourly Rate Schedule as further described in Section E (Compensation) of **Exhibit "A"** of this Amendment. Part 1, Part 2, and Part 3 Services will be a total not-to-exceed cost of \$2,161,832.85.

4. The Agreement, as amended by this Amendment #2, continues in full force and effect.

EXHIBIT A CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT <u>NO.17-063</u> BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POLK COUNTY GIBSON OAKS WATER PRODUCTION FACILITY(PART 3) AMENDMENT #2

Carollo Engineers, Inc., (CONSULTANT) entered into a Consulting Services Agreement (AGREEMENT) with Polk County, Florida (COUNTY) on **August 4, 2017.** Pursuant to the AGREEMENT, the COUNTY has requested that the CONSULTANT provide certain professional services in support of the **Gibson Oaks Water Production Facility** (Project) as further detailed in this Exhibit.

A. PROJECT BACKGROUND AND DESCRIPTION

The Northwest Regional Utility Service Area (NWRUSA) provides potable water, wastewater, and reclaimed water service in the northwestern portion of Polk County. The NWRUSA is bordered to the north by the Green Swamp, to the southeast by Interstate 4, to the south by the City of Lakeland, and to the west by the Polk County/Hillsborough County Line. The potable water system serving the County's NWRUSA consists of seven (7) separate potable water production facilities (WPF's). Six of the individual water production facilities including Sherwood Lakes, Homestead, Indianwood, Timber Ridge, Lake Gibson, and Mann Road are all interconnected as the Northwest Public Water Supply (PWS) system.

The 2013 NWRUSA Potable Water Production Regionalization Study and 2016 Master Plan Update recommended that the six (6) existing WPF's in the Northwest PWS be consolidated into three (3) regional facilities to improve water system reliability and meet future demands more efficiently. The Gibson Oaks WPF (Project) will be a regional facility in the eastern portion of the NWRUSA and will replace the existing Lake Gibson, Timbe Ridge, and Sherwood Lakes WPF's. The Project will increase water system reliability/redundancy by providing a second potable water distribution system loop in the eastern portion of the service area. Additionally, the Project is intended to provide additional WPF capacity needed to serve existing and future development in the area. The 2015 NWRUSA Master Plan Update recommends that the Project be operational by 2020 to meet growing service area demands.

The PART 1 scope of services included support services, preliminary design and permitting as well as bid and construction phase services for a new potable production well. The PART 2 scope of services included final design, permitting, bidding and construction phase services for the Gibson Oaks WPF, including offsite potable water and raw water main improvements associated with the Project. The COUNTY has requested that the CONSULTANT proceed with PART 3 of the Project, consisting of additional construction phase services for the Gibson Oaks WPF due to a longer construction duration, with additional construction documents for the CONSULTANT to review, than originally contracted to the CONSULTANT in PART 2.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Upon authorization to proceed from the COUNTY, the CONSULTANT will provide the following identified services. The CONSULTANT shall provide that the design, bid, and construction documents produced by the CONSULTANT or their subconsultants for the COUNTY will be consistent with the Polk County Utilities Standards and Specifications Manual (USSM), latest edition, and other COUNTY requirements. This authorization shall be in full force and effect until the CONSULTANT completes the services described in this Amendment and any subsequent modifications to the AGREEMENT.

PHASE 700 - CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES

These services will be performed during construction of the Project.

Task 703 - Shop Drawing Review (Gibson Oaks WPF)

Review contractor's shop drawings and other submittals for general conformance with the Contract Documents. CONSULTANT shall conduct up to 132 additional submittal reviews, including initial submittals and re-submittals.

Task 704 - Construction Progress Meetings (Gibson Oaks WPF)

CONSULTANT shall attend twenty-five (25) additional construction progress meetings and prepare meeting agendas and meeting summaries.

Task 705 - Construction Site Visits (Gibson Oaks WPF)

The CONSULTANT's Engineer of Record (EOR), or designated representative, will conduct an additional fifteen (15) site visits during the construction of the Project.

Task 706 - Applications for Payment (Gibson Oaks WPF)

The CONSULTANT will review an additional eleven (11) Applications for Payment submitted by the contractor, including updated progress schedules, and will indicate in writing to the COUNTY a recommendation of payment or return the application to the contractor specifying in writing the reasons for not recommending payment. The CONSULTANT's recommendation of payment will constitute a representation by the CONSULTANT to the COUNTY that:

- 1. The work has progressed to the point indicated;
- 2. The quality of the work, as observed by the CONSULTANT and/or reported to the CONSULTANT by the COUNTY staff in direct observation of the work, is generally in accordance with the Contract Documents; and
- 3. The conditions precedent to the contractor's being entitled to such payment appear to have been fulfilled based on the CONSULTANT'S site observations.

In the event that the work has not progressed in accordance with the approved construction schedule, the CONSULTANT will request that the contractor submit a schedule recovery plan indicating corrective actions necessary to put the work back on schedule. The CONSULTANT shall submit the contractor's Application for Payment to the COUNTY within five (5) working days of receipt of the same.

Task 707 - Requests for Information (RFIs) (Gibson Oaks WPF)

Review RFIs submitted by the contractor and provide written responses to the contractor. The CONSULTANT shall maintain an RFI log for the Project. The CONSULTANT shall review and respond to an additional nineteen (19) RFI's.

C. DELIVERABLES

The CONSULTANT shall prepare and submit to the COUNTY, including electronic format when applicable, the following deliverables:

D. SCHEDULE

CONSULTANT will continue with the services identified in this Amendment immediately upon receipt of an executed copy of this Amendment. The projected schedule for the performance of services described herein is included as Attachment A-1. An updated electronic version of the project schedule in Microsoft Project (version 2013 or later) will be provided to the COUNTY within 10 working days from the issuance of the NTP. Delivery of the schedule may be in other electronic formats so long as they accurately portray the approved scope of services with sufficient detail subject to staff approval. Should additional time be required beyond the schedule depicted in Attachment A-1, the Consultant will provide an updated Attachment A-1 (schedule) to the Utilities and Procurement Divisions. Following staff approval, the updated Attachment A-1 will be forwarded by Utilities staff to Procurement staff for inclusion in the contract file with no further administration action required for extension.

E. COMPENSATION

This Amendment establishes a not-to-exceed cost of **\$136,477.00.** Compensation for the services performed under this Amendment shall be on an hourly, not-to-exceed basis using the current hourly rate schedule as set forth in Exhibit B. A summary of the estimated labor costs and reimbursable expenses is provided in Attachment A-2. Each invoice submittal shall include a tabular summary of the originally estimated labor costs by phase in accordance with Attachment A-2, fees invoiced to date, and the balance remaining per phase. The transfer of funds between defined phases is not permitted unless approved in advance in writing by the COUNTY Utilities Director. To request consideration for such a transfer, the CONSULTANT must submit satisfactory written justification to transfer unused funds from phases with completed tasks or tasks clearly tracking under budget to phases with tasks requiring additional funding. In addition, the transfer of funds shall not exceed the total authorized fee for the Project.

The not-to-exceed cost for PART 3 of the Project as outlined in Amendment #2 to the AGREEMENT does not include an Allowance for Permit Fees. The COUNTY shall pay all permit fees.

The CONSULTANT will minimally provide a consultant invoice summary spreadsheet (spend plan) with each invoice, based on a mutually agreed-upon breakdown of phases and tasks in Attachment 2 that reflects the effort and deliverables submitted to the COUNTY. The summary will depict the overall phases, associated budgets, amounts invoiced to date, and balance remaining. Invoices for compensation submitted by the CONSULTANT will include the reviewed and approved consultant invoice summary, an updated project schedule, and the monthly status report.

Invoices for not-to-exceed projects shall be accompanied by time and task records for all billable hours appearing on the invoice. Additional documentation may be requested by the COUNTY and, if so requested, shall be furnished by the CONSULTANT to the COUNTY Auditor's satisfaction. In addition, all invoices shall be submitted with the CSA number, purchase order (PO) number, Polk County Utilities Project (Oracle) and Records Room numbers on the invoice.

The CONSULTANT agrees that, in the event that design errors and/or omissions are discovered during construction, these services rendered by the CONSULTANT to correct said design errors and/or omissions will be considered out-of-scope services and shall not be invoiced to the COUNTY.

F. COUNTY'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The COUNTY will provide the following information to the CONSULTANT and/or perform the following services related to the Project:

- ► Allow CONSULTANT scheduled access to the sites.
- Assign one (1) project manager to coordinate internal reviews and comments of the submittals as well as internal schedule for COUNTY meeting attendees.

G. SERVICES NOT INCLUDED

The following services are not included in this phase of the project and shall be added at a later date by subsequent addendum to the AGREEMENT:

- Resident Project Representative Services
- No field services for hydraulic modeling efforts
- Construction service for pre-load activities.

H. ASSUMPTIONS


