NOTICE OF INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE (ISS) 25-627

Purchase, Maintenance, and Repair of Aurora & Layne Verti-Line, Flowserve, Howden, Hydromatic, Myers, and National pumps and KSB pumping and mixing equipment

Polk County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida has standardized to Aurora & Layne Verti-Line, Flowserve, Howden, Hydromatic, Myers, and National pumps and KSB pumping and mixing equipment at various wastewater treatment facilities.

It is the intent of Polk County to sole source the purchase of equipment, OEM parts, and warranty repair services with Barney's Pumps, Inc. for the next five (5) years. Barney's Pumps have identified themselves as the sole distributor and authorized facility to provide warranty and non-warranty service and repair for these products in the state of Florida, exclusive of the panhandle counties west of the Apalachicola River.

SUMMARY:

Provide products and OEM replacement parts, maintenance, repair services, field service, and technical support for Aurora & Layne Verti-Line, Flowserve, Howden, Hydromatic, KSB, Myers, and National pumps.

Various types of pumps are utilized by the Utilities Division. Standardization of these products allows for like-to-like replacement. The County currently utilizes Aurora & Layne Verti-Line, Flowserve, Howden, Hydromatic, KSB, Myers, and National pumps at various lift stations and treatment facilities and are essential to the operations of those sites throughout the County. The pumps are used in the process to move sewage through the wastewater infrastructure system and are needed for the disinfection process at the treatment facilities.
