CONTRACT FOR FUNDING
CONTRACT # 26-587-CHC**

This Contract for Funding ("Contract") is made effective from **July 27, 2026** ("Effective Date") to **July 26, 2027** by and between Central Florida Health Care, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("CFHC"), and Polk County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("COUNTY") (CFHC and COUNTY shall be referred to jointly as the "Parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, one of the goals of the Polk County Ordinance 2015-76, the Polk County Indigent Health Care Plan Extension Ordinance (the "Ordinance") is for the County to fund care for indigent residents of the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance directs the proceeds from the tax imposed to be expended to provide health care to "qualified resident" as defined within the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, organizations may submit proposals for funding for review by the Citizens Healthcare Oversight Committee (the "COC") to ensure the integrity, service, and stewardship of the quality of indigent healthcare in the County; and

WHEREAS, CFHC is a Federally Qualified Health Center providing medical, dental, pediatric, gynecology, behavioral health and optometry services throughout Polk County; and

WHEREAS, CFHC submitted a proposal for funding for the purchase of medical, dental, and diagnostic equipment for their Lakeland Community Health Center location to expand services to include: primary care, specialty care, and dental from which it will provide medical services to Polk County residents who are "qualified residents;" and;

WHEREAS, the COC approved and recommended that the COUNTY approve CFHC's proposal for funding upon the terms and conditions described in this Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Recitals. The forgoing recitals are true correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Funding, Procedures for Invoicing and Payment.
 - a. The COUNTY agrees to pay CFHC an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred and Twelve Thousand One Hundred and Sixteen and 53/100 dollars (\$1,512,116.53) as described in Exhibit C (the "Budget") for reimbursement of the purchase of medical equipment. CFHC has provided to the COUNTY quotes, list attached hereto as Exhibit E and incorporated herein by reference (the "Expenses"), based on anticipated needs to be used solely within CFHC clinics located in Lakeland, Florida.

Notwithstanding the foregoing or anything to the contrary contained herein, COUNTY's obligation to pay the aforementioned amount is expressly contingent on approval by the COUNTY's Board of County Commissioners of the referenced budgeted amount.
 - b. Upon purchase of Expenses, CFHC shall deliver, or cause to be delivered an invoice for reimbursement of Expenses as described in Exhibit D (Invoice Template). Supporting documentation for invoice(s) shall include copy of vendor invoice, packing list, date and signature of the person receiving the item, and copy of payment.
 - c. The COUNTY may, at its discretion, inspect any documents, records, and files retained by CFHC to verify accuracy of all submitted invoices and reports.

- d. Upon receiving the invoices and supporting documentation, the COUNTY shall review such invoices and supporting documentation to determine whether the invoiced items are proper for payment. The COUNTY will pay CFHC for Expenses based upon approved invoices.
- e. CFHC agrees to return to the COUNTY any overpayments of funds disallowed pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Contract. In the event that the Parties or their independent auditors discover that an overpayment has been made, the overpayment shall be repaid immediately without prior notification from the COUNTY. In the event that the COUNTY first discovers an overpayment has been made, the COUNTY will notify CFHC of such findings.
- f. As a condition of accepting said funds from the COUNTY, CFHC agrees that for ten (10) years from the Effective Date:

1. CFHC will not sell or transfer any portion of the medical equipment. Notwithstanding the foregoing, CFHC shall not be deemed in breach of this Contract if CFHC merges or consolidates with another nonprofit organization that is recognized as exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, provided that (i) the successor entity continues to use the medical equipment for the purpose of providing healthcare services to "qualified residents" and maintains a Contract for Services with the COUNTY for the remainder of the ten year period, and (ii) CFHC provides the COUNTY with prior written notice of such merger or consolidation together with reasonable documentation establishing the successor entity's 501(c)(3) status and its agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement;

2. CFHC will maintain a Contract for Services with the COUNTY to provide health care services to "qualified residents;" and

3. CFHC will continuously provide health care services to "qualified residents."

Should CFHC fail to meet one or more of these conditions, then within thirty (30) days, CFHC shall repay the COUNTY the full amount of the Award. This provision shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Contract and shall continue in force and effect until the expiration of the repayment period described in this section.

3. Financial Responsibility. CFHC agrees as follows:

- a. CFHC gives the COUNTY, through any authorized representative, access to and the right to examine all records, books, papers, or documents relating to the services provided and expenses incurred under the terms of this Contract.
- b. CFHC agrees to maintain books, records, and documents in accordance with accounting procedures and practices which sufficiently and properly reflect all expenditures of the funding provided under this Contract.
- c. CFHC further agrees that funding provided through this Contract for Equipment will be utilized solely for the CFHC Lakeland location and in accordance with quotes provided. CFHC further agrees to provide for audit purposes (upon request) all files, records and documents pertaining to inventory of Equipment. CFHC should be able to physically present items purchased to COUNTY's authorized representative.
- d. Any funds expended in violation of the Contract shall be refunded in full by CFHC to COUNTY from non-federal and non-state resources.

4. Assurances/General Provisions. CFHC agrees to comply with all other applicable Federal, State, and County laws, ordinances, codes and regulations. Any conflict or inconsistency between the above Federal, State or County guidelines and regulations and this Contract shall be resolved in favor of the more restrictive regulations.

- a. CFHC certifies compliance with Paragraph (2)(a) of Section 287.133 Florida Statutes, which provides that a "person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided

in Section 287.017, for CATEGORY TWO for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.” CFHC acknowledges that this Contract shall be void if they have violated the above-referenced statute. Additionally, CFHC shall ensure compliance with the U.S. Department of Health Office of Inspector General Medicare/Medicaid fraud, waste, and abuse requirements.

b. Public Meetings and Records.

- i. CFHC acknowledges the COUNTY’s obligations under Article I, Section 24, of the Florida Constitution and under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, to release public records to members of the public upon request and comply in the handling of the materials created under this Contract. CFHC further acknowledges that the constitutional and statutory provisions control over the terms of this Contract. In association with its performance pursuant to this Contract, CFHC shall not release or otherwise disclose the content of any documents or information that is specifically exempt from disclosure pursuant to all applicable laws.
- ii. Without in any manner limiting the generality of the foregoing, to the extent applicable, CFHC acknowledges its obligations to comply with Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, with regard to public records, and shall:
- iii. keep and maintain public records required by the COUNTY to perform the Services required under this Contract;
- iv. upon request from the COUNTY’s Custodian of Public Records or his/her designee, provide the COUNTY with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or as otherwise provided by law;
- v. ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the term of this Contract and following completion of this Contract if CFHC does not transfer the records to the COUNTY; and
- vi. upon completion of this Contract, transfer, at no cost, to the COUNTY all public records in possession of CFHC or keep and maintain public records required by the COUNTY to perform the service. If CFHC transfers all public records to the COUNTY upon completion of this Contract, CFHC shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If CFHC keeps and maintains public records upon completion of this Contract, CFHC shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the COUNTY, upon request from the COUNTY’s Custodian of Public Records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the COUNTY.

c. IF CFHC HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO CFHC’S DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS CONTRACT, CONTACT THE COUNTY’S CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS AT:

d. Employment Eligibility Verification (E-Verify)

- i. Unless otherwise defined herein, terms used in this Section which are defined in Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time, shall have the meaning ascribed in said statute.
- ii. Pursuant to Section 448.095 (5), Florida Statutes, the contractor hereto, and any subcontractor thereof must register with and use the E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all new employees of the contractor or subcontractor. The contractor acknowledges and agrees that (i) the County and the contractor may not enter into this Agreement, and the contractor may not enter into any subcontracts hereunder, unless each party to this Agreement, and each party to any subcontracts hereunder, registers with and uses the E-Verify system; and (ii) use of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System and compliance with all other terms of this Certification and Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, is an express condition of this Agreement, and the County may treat a failure to comply as a material breach of this Agreement.
- iii. By entering into this Agreement, the contractor becomes obligated to comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, "Employment Eligibility," as amended from time to time. This includes but is not limited to utilization of the E-Verify System to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees and requiring all subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. The contractor shall maintain a copy of such affidavit for the duration of this Agreement. Failure to comply will lead to termination of this Agreement, or if a subcontractor knowingly violates the statute or Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. If this Agreement is terminated pursuant to Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, such termination is not a breach of contract and may not be considered as such. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Tenth Judicial Circuit Court of Florida no later than 20 calendar days after the date of termination. If this Agreement is terminated for a violation of Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, by the contractor, the contractor may not be awarded a public contract for a period of 1 year after the date of termination. The contractor shall be liable for any additional costs incurred by the County as a result of the termination of this Agreement. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow intentional discrimination of any class protected by law.
- e. No Coercion for Labor or Services. Concurrently with its execution of this Contract, CFHC has executed an affidavit (Exhibit A) which has been signed by an officer or representative of CFHC under penalty of perjury attesting that CFHC does not use coercion for labor or services as those terms are defined in Florida Statutes, § 787.06, as that statute may be subsequently revised or amended. Failure to provide the required affidavit is a material default of this Contract. CFHC shall provide the County the same type of affidavit upon any renewal or extension of the Contract as required by Section 787.06.
- f. Foreign Country of Concern Attestation. Concurrently with its execution of this Contract, CFHC has executed an affidavit (Exhibit B) which has been signed by an officer or representative of CFHC under penalty of perjury attesting that CFHC does not meet any of the criteria stated in Florida Statutes, § 287.138(2), as that statute may be subsequently revised or amended. Receipt of the required affidavit is a condition precedent to this Contract. CFHC shall provide the County the same type of affidavit upon any renewal or extension of the Contract as required by Section 287.138.
- g. The entire Contract between the Parties and its corresponding Exhibits are set forth herein and contained within this document and the Parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements, or understandings concerning the subject matter of this Contract that are not contained herein. Accordingly, it is agreed that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representations or agreements whether oral or written.
5. Conflict of Interest. No person who is an employee, agent, consultant, officer, or appointed official of CFHC and who is in a position to participate in a decision making process or gain inside information with regard to activities relevant to the terms of this Contract, may obtain a personal or financial interest or benefit from the activity, or have an interest in any contract, subcontract, or agreement with respect thereto, or the proceeds there under, either for themselves or those with whom they have family or business ties, during their tenure or for one (1) year thereafter.

6. Indemnification. CFHC shall indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY, its agents, and employees, from all suits, actions, claims, demands, damages, losses, expenses, including attorney's fees, costs and judgments of every kind and description to which the COUNTY, its agents or employees may be subjected to by reason of injury to persons or death or property damage, resulting from or growing out of any action of commission, omission, negligence or fault of CFHC or its qualified physicians committed in connection with this Contract, CFHC's performance hereof or any work performed hereunder. CFHC shall indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY, its agent and employees, from all suits, actions, claims, demands, damages, losses, expenses, including attorney's fees, costs of judgments of every kind and description arising from, based upon or growing out of the violation of any Federal, State, County or City law, ordinance or regulation by CFHC or its agents and employees. Funds made available pursuant to this Contract shall not be used by CFHC for the purpose of initiating or pursuing litigation against the COUNTY.
7. Notices. All notices required by this Contract shall be in writing. All notices, requests, demands or communication required, permitted or desired to be given hereunder shall be deemed effectively given when personally delivered or sent by fax with copy sent by overnight courier, addressed as follows:

Or to such other address as such party has specified by notice in writing to the other party. Notice shall be deemed to have been duly given when: (a) received, if personally delivered; (b) the day after it is sent, if sent by recognized expedited delivery services; or (c) three (3) days after it is sent, if mailed, first class mail, postage prepaid.

8. Termination.
- a. Either of the Parties may terminate this Contract upon five (5) days prior written notice to the other. In the event of a breach of this Contract, either of the Parties may terminate this Contract immediately, upon receipt of written notice by the other. The COUNTY may take any other remedy or action that may be legally available to it in the event of such breach.
 - b. This Contract may be terminated at the option of the COUNTY if CFHC is found to have been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel. In addition, this Contract may be terminated at the option of the COUNTY if CFHC is found to have submitted a false certification as provided under Section 287.135(5), Florida Statutes; has been placed on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List; or has been engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.
9. Counterparts. This document shall be executed in two (2) counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original.
