They've also got a INDUSTRIAL WASTE Pipe running along the Right of way a very few feet from our water well. We have the diagram stating so signed by Bob Elliot of Fort Meade.

We haven't drunk our water for many years we shouldn't be forced to drink bottled water as it gets costly .

We have a right to clean water which due to Mosaic Mining we do not nor does anyone else near here .

Polk County keeps permitting Mosaic to mine with out knowing the truth of what the mine does either that or they don't care because it's not near them it is near and around us and we want it stopped .

AGREEMENT FOR FURNISHING AND USING REUSE WATER

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 11th day of August, 1995, between the City of Fort Meade, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called the "CITY", and Mobil Mining and Minerals Company, a New York corporation, hereinafter called "Mobil",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Mobil owns and is constructing a phosphate mining and processing facility located south of the City (hereinafter called "Facility"), and Mobil will own, operate, and maintain this Facility for an estimated 25 years into the future, and;

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a secondary wastewater treatment facility, hereinafter sometimes called (WWTF) which produces a liquid effluent commonly known as "reclaimed water", or "reuse" or "graywater", and;

WHEREAS, Polk County has recently completed a County-wide Water (Wastewater) Reuse Study, and this Study identified a potential reuse scenario wherein, Mobil would use City's reclaimed water in its Facility, and;

WHEREAS, the use of reclaimed water is supported by Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD), and;

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement a long-term disposal plan for the reuse water produced by the City's secondary WWTF and Mobil desires to use the City's reuse water within the overall operations of its Facility, and;

WHEREAS, the parties intend to set forth in this Agreement certain obligations, rights, duties, covenants, and agreements relating to the City's obligation with respect to furnishing reuse water to Mobil and Mobil's obligation with respect to use of said reuse water within its Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the City and Mobil agree as follows:
