WHEREAS, the Polk County Roads & Drainage Division, conducted parking studies on the following County-maintained Local Residential road:

Old Kissimmee Road (Road Number 671203); from County Road 54 (Ronald Reagan Parkway) to Osceola County Line, Located in S-12, T-26S, R-27E, and

WHEREAS, said studies were made in accordance with the procedures established by the State of Florida Department of Transportation, and said studies verified that the parking of vehicles in this location creates ingress and egress concerns, and

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Florida, the Board of County Commissioners is vested with the authority to restrict parking on County maintained roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Polk County Roads & Drainage Division is herewith directed to cause Old Kissimmee Road to be posted "No Parking, Stopping or Standing" on the southeast side from 4 Acres Lane to 350' northeast of 4 Acres Lane.
