

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-\_\_\_\_\_**

**RESOLUTION REQUIRING THAT ALL CANDIDATES WHO QUALIFY BEFORE THE POLK COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS TO FILE ALL CAMPAIGN REPORTS ELECTRONICALLY; SPECIFYING THAT EACH REPORT FILED IS CONSIDERED TO BE UNDER OATH OF THE CANDIDATE AND TREASURER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 106.0705, Fla. Stat., sets out the requirements for the electronic filing of campaign treasurers' reports; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 106.0705, Fla. Stat., further states that each report filed pursuant to the section is considered to be under oath of the candidate and treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 106.07(2)(a)2., Fla. Stat., authorizes the Board of the County Commissioners to impose upon its own officers and candidates electronic filing requirements not in conflict with Section 106.0705, Fla. Stat.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Polk County Supervisor of Elections has requested the Polk County Board of County Commissioners adopt a resolution requiring electronic filing of officers and candidates who qualify before the Polk County Supervisor of Elections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

1. **REQUIREMENT TO FILE ELECTRONICALLY WITH THE POLK COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS.** All officers and candidates that qualify before the Polk County Supervisor of Elections shall file reports electronically in accordance with Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. All reports filed shall be considered under oath of the candidate and treasurer.
2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
